## FEBRUARY:

## SEPTEMBER:

 29th—Theory of Music Examinations.

## OCTOBER:

2nd—Examinations of A.M.E.B. candidates by Mr. Gordon Short. In the afternoon Sir Richard Terry examines in Art of Speech on behalf of Trinity College.  
 5th—First visit of Dom Moreno in preparation for Congress Mass.  
 6th—A.M.E.B. examination of Violin and Junior Piano pupils by Mr. Cyril Monk. Intermediate Christian Doctrine examination.  
 8th—Results of Music and Art of Speech announced: 100% passes, many honours.  
 11th—Visit from Mother Prioress of *Santa Sabina*.  
 17th—A kind friend, Mr. Brown, shows moving pictures (including the Eucharistic Congress) in the Hall at *San Clemente*.  
 21st—Diocesan Bursary examination begins.
